Orff Schulwerk's adaptability to musical styles of diverse countries is one of its most profound contributions to music education. However, the marriage of the Schulwerk with a particular musical culture works best when the partners agree on the importance of learning through the body, the voice and the ear, using simple elements that combine to create complex, dynamic music, keeping movement side-by-side with the music and improvisation at the center of it all. Hence, the perfect wedding of Jazz and Orff Schulwerk, a theme I've developed with children and adults for over 40 years.

Come prepared to learn how to make the complexities of jazz accessible to young children, how to adapt jazz pieces to the Orff instruments and discover your own hidden jazz musician in the process. Those who play band instruments should bring them to add to the ensemble. This workshop is suitable for those working with the primary and secondary age range.

He worked with children in The San Francisco School for 45 years until his retirement in 2020 and continues working as a consultant, mentor, guest teacher, workshop leader and performer in schools locally, nationally and internationally. He is the director of and teacher in the prestigious San Francisco International Orff Course and the Jazz/Orff Course, is the author of many books and produces his own Podcast, The ABC's of Education. Doug is featured in the documentary film The Secret Song that screened in some 25 film festivals and is currently streaming on Amazon Prime, Apple TV and PBS.
