The workshop is suitable for all teachers with some experience in teaching music, as specialists or generalists; and for musicians who work in education or community settings with children in the 6 to 14 age range. The content is relevant to the Irish Arts Curriculum.

Creative learning and group learning are at the core of the Orff approach. In this workshop we will use percussion instruments to build pieces based on imagery and rhythm, and we will explore some basic ideas for movement improvisation and composition. Reflecting on these models we will analyse possible strategies for structuring collaborative creative learning processes with groups of children.

Andrea Sangiorgio was appointed Professor of Elemental Music Education at the University of Music and Performing Arts in Munich, Germany in December 2015.

He studied at the Orff-Institute, Salzburg and gained a PhD at the University of Exeter with a research study on children's group creativity. Since 1997 he has been co-director of CDM Centro Didattico Musicale, a private music school in Rome. In July 2018 he was nominated vice-president of the International Orff-Schulwerk Forum Salzburg. He has led workshops for teachers in the UK, in Europe and beyond. He was our lead tutor for the 2013 International Summer School in York.
